Scholarship Application 2024

The Ultimate Junior Development scholarship program administered by the Manitoba Organization of Disc Sports (MODS) was established to support young athletes who continue to participate in Ultimate while pursuing a post-secondary education on a full-time basis.

The program's emphasis is placed on athletes who have competed at the provincial level or higher during the 2023 -2024 season, and who have maintained a high level of academic standing, while showing a commitment to Ultimate through their involvement in playing, coaching, observing and volunteer activities. There are three scholarships available: the "Dean Wright Scholarship", the "Dr. Colin Yeung Scholarship" and the "Jean-Luc Forest – Spirit of the Game Scholarship". The value of these scholarships will be \$500.00 each. Preference will be given to graduating high school athletes attending university or college in Manitoba during the 2024-2025 school year.

These scholarships are in recognition of the outstanding contribution these men have made to the junior Ultimate program in Manitoba. Their continued efforts to improve the sport of Ultimate in Winnipeg and across Canada were the inspiration for these awards.

Eligibility Criteria:

- a) Applicants must have participated in a MODS or Ultimate Canada-sanctioned event in 2023 / 2024.
- b) Attend a university or college as a full-time student for the 2024 / 2025 regular academic sessions.
- c) Have been a resident of Manitoba since April 1, 2021.
