

# **MANITOBA ORGANIZATION OF DISC SPORTS (MODS) BINGO POLICY**

## **Preamble**

1. The MODS Bingo policy covers the allocation of Bingo session opportunities to approved high performance teams or other approved MODS groups and the requirements of the teams and groups for these sessions. It also covers the use of and reporting of these funds to MODS.

## **Scope**

2. This policy applies to all provincial team representatives, members and volunteers of Disc Golf and Ultimate Frisbee and all other MODS volunteers and employees.

## **Scheme**

3.

- To receive a Bingo session opportunity teams must fulfill all the duties required of provincial teams as per our “High Performance Policy”. Disc Golf and other MODS groups may be allocated a Bingo session as deemed appropriate by the MODS’ Board of Directors.
- In the instance that there are more provincial teams / groups applying for Bingo sessions than Bingo sessions allocated to the organization the MODS board will determine how to award the sessions and the funds raised from them.
- Each team / group is responsible to have a “Bingo Chairperson” who will recruit the necessary volunteers for their session. The Bingo Chairperson will report to the MODS Executive Director (ED) with the complete list of volunteers and their contact info.
- The ED will contact the volunteer list 48 hours prior to the Bingo session; the volunteers must reply back with confirmation to the ED of their attendance for the event.
- At the event the Bingo Chairperson will be in direct contact with the casinos Bingo Supervisor and must be available for the entire session.

- Teams / groups must comply with all components of the High Performance and Bingo Policies to receive their funding.
- Funds acquired by a team or group may only be spent on behalf of the team to cover or reimburse costs involved in team registration, training, travel and equipment costs. The use of these funds must be reported to the Executive Director at the conclusion of the team's season as outlined in the High Performance Policy.

### **Approval**

4. This policy was approved by the MODS' Board of Directors on March 11, 2008. It will be reviewed on an annual basis and may be amended, deleted or replaced by a resolution of the Board.
