Scholarship Application 2009

The Ultimate Junior Development scholarship program administered by the Manitoba Organization of Disc Sports (MODS) was established to support young athletes who continue to participate in Ultimate while pursuing a post secondary education on a full time basis.

The program's emphasis is placed on athletes who have competed at the provincial level or higher during 2008, and who have maintained a high level of academic standing, while showing a commitment to Ultimate through their involvement in playing, coaching, observing and volunteer activities. There are two scholarships available; the "Dean Wright Scholarship" and the "Dr. Colin Yeung Scholarship". The value of these scholarships will depend on the funds available for distribution but will be a minimum of two hundred and fifty dollars each. Preference will be given to athletes attending university or college in Manitoba.

Scholarships are awarded to graduating high school students entering a post secondary institution and to students in their second year in a post secondary institution. Preference will be given to graduating students entering their first year.

These scholarships are in recognition of the outstanding contribution these men have made to junior Ultimate in Manitoba. Their continued efforts to improve the sport of Ultimate here in Winnipeg and across Canada were the inspiration for these awards.

Eligibility Criteria:

- a) Applicants must have participated in a MODS or Canadian Ultimate Player Association (CUPA) sanctioned event in 2008.
- b) Be attending a university or college as a full time student for the 2009 / 2010 regular academic sessions.
- c) Have been a resident of Manitoba since April 1, 2008.
