

## **Manitoba Organization of Disc Sports**

## Canadian 4-on-4 Junior Ultimate Championships, April 1-2, 2023, Oshawa, Ontario.

Manitoba Organization of Disc Sports (MODS) is excited to announce that we will be submitting a bid to have a Junior aged team representing Manitoba at the Canadian 4-on-4 Ultimate Championships, hosted by Ultimate Canada, on Saturday, April 1, 2023, and Sunday, April 2, 2023, in Oshawa, Ontario. MODS will be selecting 10 to 12 ultimate athletes to play in the Junior Mixed Division. Eligible athletes must be no older than 18 years of age and no younger than 14 years of age on December 31, 2023.

The team will be selected through a series of open tryouts taking place on the dates shown below. As this is a mixed tournament, with two athletes of each gender on the field, the team will consist of an equal number of players from each gender. If an athlete identifies as non-binary or prefers to not disclose their gender, they will be considered for selection and competition purposes using the gender they prefer to match up against in competition. The team will be selected by current Team Manitoba coaches and the 4-on-4 head coach Dean Wright.

Following tryouts, those selected will be informed by Wednesday, February 8. The team will practice, each Sunday from February 12 to March 26 @WSF North 4:45 pm to 5:45 pm. The practice fee is \$150 per player.

The team will fly to Toronto Pearson Airport on Friday, March 31, and return to Winnipeg on Monday, April 3. Upon arrival in Toronto, the team will travel in rental vehicles to a hotel near the sports complex in Oshawa. The tournament will take place on Saturday, April 1 and Sunday, April 2.

The approximate cost of the trip will be \$1000-\$1200. This will include airfare, accommodations, vehicle rental and gas, tournament fees, and coaches' expenses. Tryout fees, purchase of uniforms, MODS fees and Ultimate Canada fees will be extras. While in Oshawa, players will be responsible for paying for their own meals and snacks.


While training, travelling and competing with the team, all team members will be expected to adhere to the MODS Code of Conduct Policy, which must be read by all team members and their parents.
