1. Purpose

To guide the selection process for MODS Lifetime Member and Volunteer of the Year decisions.


2. Protocol

- 1. During June, appoint a Board Member to chair the Lifetime Member and Volunteer of the Year selection process. By default, this responsibility falls to the Vice President.
- 2. During July, advertise to membership that nominations are being accepted for Lifetime Member and Volunteer of the Year recognition and circulate nomination form.
- 3. By August 21, all nominations must have been submitted. Late submissions may be considered at the discretion of the Board of Directors.
- 4. By September 1, all nominations including prior year nominations that were not recognized are forwarded to the Lifetime Member and Volunteer of the Year Chair for review.
- 5. Lifetime Member and Volunteer of the Year Chair may solicit additional volunteers to assist with the evaluation process of Lifetime Member and Volunteer of the Year candidates.
- 6. By the September Board Meeting, Lifetime Member and Volunteer of the Year Chair to present the evaluations of all candidates for Lifetime Member and Volunteer of the Year, along with their recommendation for Lifetime Member and Volunteer of the Year recognition.
- 7. During the September Board Meeting, the Board of Directors discusses candidates, may nominate a candidate that may have been missed and votes for Lifetime Member and Volunteer of the Year.
- 8. Staff to contact the successful nominee(s) to invite them and their nominator to the AGM.

More than one Lifetime Member and one Volunteer of the Year may be recognized if there are sufficient deserving candidates, however the suggestion is to stick to one Lifetime Member and one Volunteer of the Year each year.
