1. INTRODUCTION

Purpose

To select the provincial teams for the 2024 Canadian Ultimate Championships.

Objective

The objective of this document is to have a fair and transparent selection process which selects the best athletes and coaches to represent Manitoba.

2. ATHLETE'S ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Junior: 1) Is one eligible to compete at the Canadian Ultimate Championships in the Juniors division.

2) Must attend a minimum of 2 of the Junior Provincial team tryouts.

Senior: Is one over the age of 18, or previously given permission to play at the Senior level. Is eligible to compete at the Canadian Ultimate Championships under Ultimate Canada standards. Has participated in MODS Senior Provincials.

3. ATHLETE GENERAL REQUIREMENTS TO MAINTAIN NOMINATION

- 1. Must be a member in good standing with MODS.
- 2. Must not be serving a suspension and anti-doping violation.

4. LOSS OF NOMINATION STATUS

- 5.1 An athlete's nomination may be withdrawn at any time, even after notification, acceptance, or signing of an Athlete's Agreement, if in the opinion of the ED, an athlete has failed to:
 - 5.1.1 Fulfill eligibility to be selected and be Invited (to the team or as an alternate);

OR

5.1.2 Fulfill ongoing obligations of the athlete under this policy.

5. REPLACEMENT OF AN ATHLETE

- 6.1 Should an injury or unforeseen circumstance prevent a selected athlete from competing at a specific event for which he or she qualified, the athlete must immediately notify MODS in writing.
- 6.2 The decision to nominate the athlete to that particular event will be made at the sole discretion of the ED.

6. EXCEPTIONAL CIRCUMSTANCES

7.1 Due to the timing of the events, no exceptional circumstances will be entertained.

7. APPROVAL AND APPEAL PROCESS

- 8.1 Final decisions on the selection of athletes to participate on a specific event shall be made by the ED.
- 8.2 Issues not otherwise addressed by this document shall be resolved by the ED.
- 8.3 Appeals on matters of Team Selections can be dealt with under the MODS Appeal Policy

8. COACH SELECTION

9.1 Coaches will be selected by the office staff based on availability, submitted interest and proven ability to work with the coaching team.

9. FUNDING TO EVENTS

10.1 Funding to events will be dependent on the event budget but are primarily self-funded.

10. SFI FCTION CRITERIA

Senior: Subject to available bids with Ultimate Canada, MODS will support the attendance of teams to the CUC based upon final placement at Senior Provincials.

Junior:

- 1) MODS will be run 4 tryouts for the Junior Provincial teams. These dates will be posted on the MODS website.
- 2) Team selection will be made by the coaches and final approval will be approved by the ED.
- 3) Coaches will be evaluating the following criteria:
 - a. Experience at a national level
 - b. Disc skills
 - c. Physical preparedness
 - d. Evidence of being a team player and team cohesion
 - e Position
 - f. Overall performance
